

Trish Bishop serves as the Director of the Virginia Retirement System, an \$80 billion public employee retirement system. VRS provides benefit administration for more than 706,000 members and beneficiaries, including several retirement plans, insurance programs and disability programs. VRS covers teachers, state employees and most employees of the Commonwealth's counties, cities, towns and political subdivisions.

Previously, Trish served as VRS' Deputy Director, responsible for implementation of benefit policy and legislation; benefit processing; retirement counseling; call center services; disbursements; employer and member training; and insurance programs.

Prior to becoming Deputy Director, Trish served as VRS' Director of Policy, Planning and Compliance where her responsibilities included liaison support with the executive branch and the General Assembly and with the systems' actuary.

Before joining VRS, Trish served as a Principal Legislative Analyst with the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC), where she participated in and led public policy research teams that evaluated a wide array of state agencies and programs. Before joining JLARC, Trish worked for the Senate of Virginia and in the executive branch.

During her 27-years in public service, Trish has been active in a number of professional and community organizations, including the National Association of State Retirement Administrators (NASRA), Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF), the Virginia Executive Institute Alumni Association, the National Legislative Program Evaluation Society (NLPES) and the American Society of Public Administration (ASPA).
